Hello,

My name is Travis Echols, I recently purchases our new home here in Herriman, in the community of High Country Estates phase 1. Lot#37

Let me start off with saying, one of the main reasons we purchased this home was the on site well and our own water rights that came with the purchase of this home.

We don't rely on the community for anything but emergency water supply such as fire! (Fire hydrant maintenance fee) Which we currently pay a standby fee of \$12.41 a month.

(Which I feel is adequate enough).

I own other properties in the Salt lake valley, and in the mid of the summer, with watering a full .25 acre my water bill with garbage and sewer my bill is only \$67 dollars a month!!!
Winter months our bill is only \$34 dollars a month.

And the purposed amount of \$47 dollars a month, I fill is too much for me as property owner with my own well and water rights!

I hope this purposed water increase can be readjusted for us property owners with our own supply of water!!

I don't feel the purposed amount should be as much for me, as someone else that is using the community water system,that will eventually need to be updated for them, not me, as a well, and water rights owner.
