RECOMMENDATION: ACKNOWLEDGE AND APPROVE

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) requests that the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) acknowledges and approves Hi-Country Estates Homeowners Association's (Company) Tariff No. 3 as attached and filed.

EXPLANATION:

The Company withdrew Tariff No. 2 on July 17, 2014. The Company has modified the language in Tariff No. 3 to meet what was previously discussed during the hearing held on July 8, 2014. The Company's modifications address the concerns of the Division and of the Commission. The Division has compared Tariff No. 3 with Tariff No. 2, the transcripts from the July 8, 2014 and the service area legal descriptions of the Report and Order in Docket 85-2010-01 and Docket 94-2195-01. The tariff complies with the Report and Order of 13-2195-02.
