**RE:** In the Matter of Community Water Company, LLC's (Community Water) Updated Tariff to Comply with the Commission's Order Issued on November 28, 2016 in Docket No. 16-098-01. Docket No. 17-098-T01.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Community Water's updated and Amended Tariff (Tariff No. 3), submitted to the Commission on or about February 2, 2017.

**EXPLANATION:**

New rates and charges were approved by Commission Order, dated November 28, 2016 under the rate case in Docket No. 16-098-01.

In accordance with the aforementioned Commission Order, on or about January 27, 2017, Community Water submitted its updated tariff, labeled Tariff No. 3, to the Commission. In the Division's initial review, it noted a statement in the tariff that was outside the Commission's Order in Docket No. 16-098-01. In bringing this to Community Water's attention, Community Water also noted a couple of other small typos they wished to correct as well.

On or about February 2, 2017, Community Water resubmitted an updated tariff, labeled Amended Tariff No. 3, to the Commission. The Division reviewed and verified that all rates,

charges and wording in Community Water's Amended Tariff No. 3 comply with the Commission's Order issued on November 28, 2016, in Docket No. 16-098-01.

**CLARIFICATION:**

On or about February 2, 2017, Terry Lange, an intervenor in Docket No. 16-098-01, sent the Commission an e-mail stating the following:

“For what it's worth, please note the *[sic]* it is Hidden Creek which had a meter installed at its pool clubhouse and not Hidden Pine. There is no Hidden Pine in the CWC customer base.”

Community Water submitted the Commission Order as “Exhibit A” in the Company's submission of its tariff. Although the tariff does not specifically address Hidden Creek (Hidden Pine), the Commission Order dated November 28, 2017, Docket No. 16-098-01, does reference in several places “Hidden Pine.”

The Division confirmed with Community Water that Mr. Lange is correct in stating that it should be Hidden Creek and not Hidden Pine.

Additionally, the Division confirmed that the meter in question was installed in the Hidden Creek Clubhouse in November 2016 and was billed in the December 2017 billing cycle as required in the Commission Order.
