The Public Service Commission (“PSC”) held a scheduling conference in this docket on December 4, 2018. During the scheduling conference, the parties agreed the Division of Public Utilities would conduct a “Follow-Up Audit” to further examine the issues it identified and described in its Memorandum, filed October 30, 2018, in Docket Nos. 17-2372-01 and 17-2372-02 (“Memorandum”). During the scheduling conference, the parties stipulated to the following schedule, which the PSC approves and adopts.

DISCOVERY AND INSTRUCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO REPORT ON RESULTS OF FOLLOW-UP AUDIT

During the scheduling conference, the PSC inquired as to the purpose of the Follow-Up Audit, and the DPU suggested that at least one purpose the DPU intended is to investigate whether the utility had remediated the problems the DPU identified in its Memorandum. The PSC believes such information to be relevant and will appreciate its inclusion in the report the DPU files on or before May 30, 2019. However, the PSC also expects the report to provide detail and specificity concerning the problems identified in the Memorandum regardless of whether the problems have been subsequently resolved.

Discovery turn-around times are fourteen calendar days until March 1, 2019, and seven calendar days thereafter. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).

NOTICE OF HEARING

The PSC will conduct a hearing in this docket on **Thursday, July 18, 2019, beginning at 1:00 p.m.** The hearing will be held in the **Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.** All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify.
