In reviewing Bridgerland Water Company's cost of doing business and taking into consideration the health and age of the people who have been performing the duties in the past, we are at the point that we need to pay employees to take over the day-to-day operations to keep the water company safe and reliable. Much of the work done in the past has been done by us and our family and that work must now be hired out. In the last couple of Home Owner meetings, Ted has said that a rate increase is coming your way. We want you to know that it is coming.
