On August 12, 2021, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order, Notice of Hearing, and Notice of Public Witness Hearing ("Scheduling Order") in this docket. On January 14, 2022, the PSC gave notice the hearings scheduled for February 9, 2022 would be held virtually. Also on January 14, 2022, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed an Unopposed Motion to Suspend Testimony Dates while Retaining Virtual Hearing Dates as Scheduled ("Motion"). The DPU asks the PSC to suspend the schedule in the Scheduling Order, except the February 9, 2022 virtual hearings.

DPU states it is engaged in settlement discussions with Bridgerland Water Company (individually, "Bridgerland" and collectively with DPU, the "Parties") and that the Parties anticipate filing a settlement stipulation before the February 9, 2022 hearing. DPU further states it is authorized to represent that Bridgerland supports the Motion. Good cause appearing, and based on DPU's representation that Bridgerland supports the Motion, the Motion is granted. The remaining testimony filing deadlines are vacated and the February 9, 2022 virtual hearing dates are retained.
