On August 3, 2023, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued its Order Granting Motion to Vacate Scheduling Order, Amended Scheduling Order, Notice of Hearing, and Notice of Public Witness Hearing (“Second Scheduling Order”) in this docket. The Second Scheduling Order maintained the previously set hearing date of August 23, 2023. On August 17, 2023, Mountain Sewer Corporation (“Mountain Sewer”) filed an Unopposed Motion Requesting Leave for Witness to Appear Virtually or by Telephone (“Motion”). In its Motion, Mountain Sewer states it has contacted counsel for the Division of Public Utilities (DPU), and that DPU has indicated it has no objection to Mountain Sewer’s witness, Ray Bowden, appearing remotely at the hearing.
