On August 3, 2023, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued its Order Granting Motion to Vacate Scheduling Order, Amended Scheduling Order, Notice of Hearing, and Notice of Public Witness Hearing (“Second Scheduling Order”) in this docket. The Second Scheduling Order maintained the previously set hearing date of August 24, 2023. On August 17, 2023, Lakeview Water Corporation (“Lakeview”) filed an Unopposed Motion Requesting Leave for Witness to Appear Virtually or by Telephone (“Motion”).
