Highlands Water Company, Inc.'s Request
to Update its Service Area

DOCKET NO. 23-010-01
ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND SETTING
VIRTUAL SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

ISSUED: August 16, 2024

On August 15, 2024, intervenors Mountain Green Mutual Water Company and Village at Trappers Loop LLC (“Intervenors”) and applicant Highlands Water Company, Inc. (“Highlands”) (collectively “Parties”) filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) a Stipulated Motion to Suspend Deadlines (“Motion”). The Motion seeks the suspension of all deadlines remaining under the current scheduling order issued April 12, 2024, and requests expedited treatment because the deadline for the submission of non-applicant written direct testimony is August 16, 2024.¹

The Motion represents that the requested suspension will “allow the parties to continue to engage in settlement negotiations and discussions about [Highlands’] responses to Intervenors’ data requests.”² The Motion further represents that the Division of Public Utilities “does not object [to the Motion] but reserves the right to seek ample response times to anything filed.”³

Good cause appearing and because there is no objection, the Motion is granted, and the current scheduling order is suspended. A scheduling conference, if necessary,

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is set as indicated below. However, if this docket is resolved before the scheduling conference date below, the Parties shall promptly file with the PSC a notice and all appropriate documents supporting the resolution.
