Comments

The purpose of this schedule is to calculate just, reasonable, and adequate rates to generate sufficient revenues to fully fund the fixed expenses and reserve requirements to promote the Company's safe, healthy, economical, efficient, and reliable operation. Just, reasonable, and adequate rates will protect the long-range interests of consumers in obtaining continued quality and proper levels of service at the lowest cost to customers.

Line 12 - Monthly Rates

This section shows the amount of expenses paid by connected and standby customers. Typically, Standby Customers pay between 20 to 30 percent of what the Connected Customers pay. Standby customers are generally not connected to the water system or using its services and pay less than connected customers. Standby charges are essentially an assessment charged to unimproved properties to ensure that adequate water service will be available for that parcel when needed.
