3 MR. DELANEY: My name is John Delany. I'm
4 the Commission's designated presiding officer for this
5 hearing. Today is November 1, 2023 and it is
6 approximately 5:04 p.m., and this is the date and time
7 that is scheduled for the members of the public to
8 comment on the settlement stipulation that is under
9 consideration in the application of Wanship Water
10 Company, LLC's request for a rate increase in Docket
11 23-067-01.

12 The notice was -- this hearing was noticed
13 to begin at five o'clock and continue until 5:30. It
14 is now 5:05 and I am not seeing anybody who appears to
15 be a member of the public that is currently present.
16 If anyone disagrees, please say so.

17 Okay. Hearing nothing, why don't we go
18 ahead and take appearances and then we will proceed
19 from there. So on behalf of the Division?

20 MR. GRECU: Patrick Grecu, Assistant
21 Attorney General, representing the Division. Mark
22 Long, our panelist, is also available.

23 MR. DELANEY: Thank you very much.
24 Wanship Water Company, LLC?

25 MR. KOHLER: Grady Kohler. I'm the owner

1 of Wanship Water.

2 MR. DELANEY: Thank you very much.
3 Anybody else going to be present for Wanship Water
4 during this public witness hearing, Mr. Kohler?

5 MR. KOHLER: No. Nobody else from Wanship.

6 MR. DELANEY: Thank you very much.

7 Well, since at this point it doesn't
8 appear that anyone from the public is present, and as I
9 said our notice indicated that this began at 5:00 but
10 would go until 5:30. If somebody is present by 5:30,
11 we will give them a reasonable opportunity to comment.
12 But I think what makes some sense now is let's go into
13 recess until the sooner of somebody showing up to
14 provide comments or 5:35. If somebody does show up
15 between now and 5:35, our staff will advise us and we
16 will circle back.

17 So pay some attention, put yourself on
18 mute, take yourself off of camera, but pay attention to
19 anybody, if anybody shows up. If they do, we will
20 reconvene. If they don't, we will meet back here about
21 5:35 and see if anybody is here. Okay?

22 MR. KOHLER: Sounds good.

23 MR. DELANEY: Does that agree with you,
24 Mr. Grecu?

25 MR. GRECU: Yes.

1 MR. DELANEY: Diana, that's fine with you?

2 REPORTER: Yes. Thank you.

3 MR. DELANEY: Okay. We will be in recess
4 for now. Thank you.

5 (Break taken from 5:07 to 5:35 p.m.)

6 MR. DELANEY: Good evening, everyone. My
7 name is John Delany. I'm the Commission's designated
8 presiding officer for this hearing. Today is November
9 1, 2023. It is --



Rule 30

(E) Submission to Witness; Changes; Signing.
