ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

ISSUED: August 27, 2024

On April 22, 2024, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a scheduling order establishing deadlines in this docket, including that non-applicant written direct testimony was due on Monday, August 26, 2024. On August 26, 2024, after close of business, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed a request for an extension requesting that the deadline for its written direct testimony be extended to September 5, 2024, and representing the extension is necessary “[d]ue to an unforeseen medical emergency of a key staff member[.]” (the “DPU Request”).

Good cause supports the DPU Request, and it is therefore granted. DPU shall have until **Thursday, September 5, 2024**, to file its written direct testimony. If applicant Mountain Green Mutual Water Company or intervenor Highlands Water Co. believes the extension is unwarranted, either may file a request seeking to establish an earlier deadline explaining why its proposed earlier deadline is appropriate.
