Dear Mr. Bramhall,

On March 11, 2025, Legacy Sweetwater, Inc. ("Legacy") filed a Request for a Letter of Exemption from the Public Service Commission (PSC) seeking the PSC's acknowledgment that Legacy is exempted from regulation (the "Request"). On April 10 and 11, 2025, several comments were filed largely opposing the Request. In addition, the Division of Public Utilities filed comments on April 9, 2025, recommending the PSC deny Legacy's Request.

On April 22, 2025, Legacy submitted correspondence to the PSC requesting a 45-day extension to respond to the comments opposing its Request. Specifically, Legacy explained the extension was necessary to retain outside counsel. The PSC granted Legacy's requested extension.

On June 18, 2025, the PSC received your correspondence indicating your appearance as Legacy's counsel and that Legacy has elected to withdraw its Request. The PSC has received no further correspondence from any stakeholder. Accordingly, the PSC gives notice that it will take no further action in this docket.
